## **Checking In**

Upon arrival at Gettysburg College, on Sunday July 15th, follow signs to Huber Hall to complete registration. Camp registration is from 2:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m.

Prior to camp be sure to complete your FCA "Permission Waiver Form" online at [www.fcalax.com/gettysburg](http://www.fcalax.com/gettysburg) or bring a completed copy with you to registration. Also, bring a copy of your insurance card too. This waiver is needed to complete the registration process, No Exceptions!

## **Fees**

All unpaid fees are due before Camp begins, NO EXCEPTIONS! Cancellations with a full refund will be accepted up until June 10<sup>th</sup>, 2012 by calling the FCA Lacrosse Office at 410-891-2643. **After June 10th, all fees, except a \$200.00 SERVICE FEE, will be refunded if you cancel your enrollment.**

**Key Deposit:** No deposit required, however, **a \$75 fee will be charged** to the enrollee for a lost key. This charge is enforced by Gettysburg College.

## **Daily Activities**

Each day of camp will allow for time with college coaches and players working with the campers to elevate their game on the field as well as off the field. ## **Early Arrival**

Camp housing is not available until 2:00 p.m. Sunday, July 15th. The first Camp meal is Sunday evening at 4:30 p.m. Any housing or meals prior to Sunday's dinner will have to be arranged and paid for by the camper through FCA Lacrosse.

## **Directions**

**From Washington D.C.**, take I-495 to I-270 North through Frederick, MD, to Route 15 North. Exit at Route 97 and turn left at the end of the exit ramp. Follow Route 97 into Gettysburg.\*

**From Baltimore**, take I-695 to I-795 North to I-140 West (through Westminster, MD) to Route 97 North.\*

\*In Gettysburg, Route 97 becomes Baltimore Street. Proceed straight to the traffic circle. At the traffic circle, proceed halfway around and take the second right, proceeding north onto Carlisle street. Follow campus signs to Huber Hall.

## **What to Wear and Bring**

Modest attire is required at all times during Camp. Such attire excludes, but is not limited to: clothing with drug, alcohol or sexually suggestive messages. No spaghetti or thin strap tops unless another shirt is worn on top or underneath. No inappropriate short shorts or tops, all clothing must conceal the midsection of your body and undergarments. Keep your clothing and equipment simple. Bring shoes and the equipment you will need for competition and clinics.

Game equipment such as balls will be provided. Bring personal gear such as a helmet/goggles, sticks, pads and cleats. You may want to bring your own water bottle and sun block.

## **Swimming**

Swimming facilities (pool) are available. In order for a camper to be allowed to use the pool a signed Student Participation Form must be

Modest swim attire is required-girls must wear a modest one-piece suit or colored tee-shirt over the swimsuit.

## **What to Bring?**

The following items are not provided so please bring: Sheets/blankets, sleeping bag, pillow, pillowcase, towels and washcloth. Bring a Fan because rooms do not have A/C.

Bring all Lacrosse Equipment (helmet, gloves, pads, stick, cleats, and mouth piece). If there is a piece of equipment that you do not have please let us know as we have extra's available to use.

## **What Not To Bring?**

Do not bring jewelry, radios, CD players, iPods, electronic games, or other expensive items.

## **Insurance**

FCA will only provide secondary insurance coverage for the camper during the stay at Camp. In case of injury or illness, campers will need to provide proof of insurance coverage at the time of treatment. A photocopy of your insurance card will be sufficient. Campers not covered by family insurance will be cared for.

## **Departing Camp**

Camp officially ends at 10:30 a.m. after the Team Chapel on Thursday, July 19th.
